### ELA:

1. Students will be able to answer what, when, and why questions from a fiction text.
2. Students will be able to describe a character's feelings and traits
3. Students will be able to explain how aspects of text illustrations emphasize a character.

5. Students will be able to identify the moral of a fable.

### MATH:

1. Students will be able to multiply within 100.

5. Students will be able to identify arithmetic patterns in the multiplication table.
6. Students will be able to explain relationships between the numbers in a pattern.
